

2024-2025 KINGDOM KIDS PRESCHOOL INFORMATION FOR ENROLLMENT

A.M. PreK Preschool Class Child must be age 4 by August 31, 2024 and fully potty trained to attend. The minimum class size is 13 students, maximum is 14 students.

4 Days a week: Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday 8:30am to 11:30am (3 hours)

Tuition \$240 a month / due the 1st of the month September through May (9 months)

Full year Tuition \$2160

P.M. Playschool Class Child must be age 3 by August 31, 2024 and fully potty trained to attend. The minimum class size is 10 students, maximum is 12 students.

3 Days a week: Monday, Tuesday and Thursday 12:15pm to 2:15pm (2 hours)

Tuition \$190 a month / due the 1st of the month September through May (9 months)

Full year Tuition \$1710

*A Non-Refundable Registration Fee of \$240 for Preschool or \$190 for Playschool is due at the time of registration.

*In the event that your child's class does not meet the minimum requirements your registration fee will be refunded to you.

*In conjunction with Washington State law, Kingdom Kids Preschool requires proof of immunization status. You will be given a C.I.S. form with your Orientation Packet, please return it with your child's registration forms to be kept on file during the school year.
