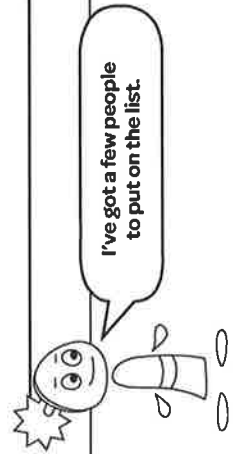
Some people carry burdens like injuries or illnesses.

Did your congregation pray for someone today? Write their name on the list below. Who would you add to that list?

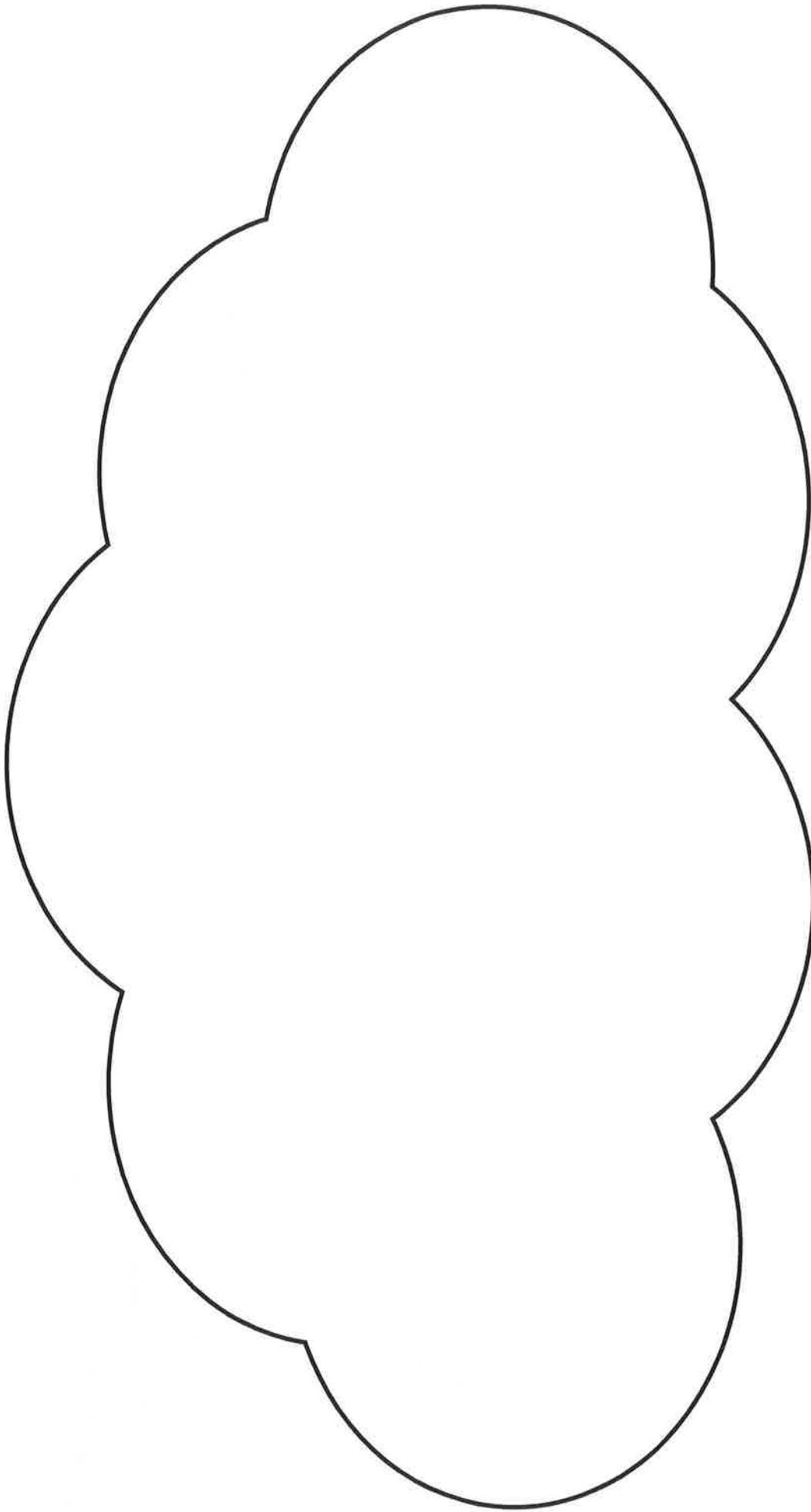
