

## Sermon Notes (Mark 4:35-41)

*The Calming of the Storm, as Mark 4:35-41 is often labeled, is a classic for a reason. It contains several details that could only come from a first hand account of the event (likely told by Peter). And, presents to us a paradigmatic story of the life of faith, especially the storms we face, following our Lord. Most of all, it invites US to answer one of life's most important questions when it comes to Jesus Christ: "Who then is this?"*

### *Questions for Reflection*

- What details do you notice in the story? What sticks out?
- How do you think you would have reacted if you were one of the disciples?
- When have you felt like "Jesus was asleep"?
- When has the Lord calmed the storms of your life?
- How would you answer the question: "Who then is this?"?

### *Praying the Passage*

- What is the main point of this passage? Talk with the Lord about it.
- Praise/Thank the Lord for the attributes, actions, and promises found in these passages.
- Confess any sins in your life this passage reveals.
- Finish the following: "Lord, help me/us to..."
