

# Restoring Lord's Day Worship at FPC of Clarkston WA June 21, 2020

Having been cleared to gather for worship, we will hold our first Lord's Day worship service on June 21, 2020. We appreciate your patience and grace as we implement some provisional changes. Here is a list of the guidelines and expectations for worship.

## General Information

- If you have symptoms of sickness (fever, cough, sore throat etc.) please stay home for the health of others and yourself.
- The service can have up to 50 people in the sanctuary (25% of its capacity). We can't wait to see you!
- All participants (except children under 2) need to wear masks until further notice.
- Practice 6 feet of physical distancing.
- Practice good hand-washing/sanitizing, etc.
- Plan for extra time to enter the building (you might want to arrive earlier than normal), as we will enter one family unit at a time.

## Entrance Guidelines

- Please enter through the courtyard doors (North doors) or the Diagonal Entrance (South doors). There will be greeters to open the doors for you.
- Upon entrance each person:
  - Will have his/her temperature taken
  - Asked the following three questions:
    - Have you been in a place with a person infected with COVID19?
    - Have you been in the company of a person infected with COVID19?
    - Have you had any symptoms of sickness (fever, cough, sore throat, etc)?
  - There will be a sign-in sheet. You do not have to sign-in. The sign-in sheet will aid us in contacting people in the event of a COVID-19 breakout.

## Worship Expectations

- Expect that God will be honored and glorified.
- Expect to encounter the Lord *together* with your church family.
- Expect that worship may look, sound, and feel different. For instance, while we will not pass a plate for the offering, *there will be* an opportunity to give as you exit the sanctuary.
- Expect that pews will be marked off. Respect restricted pews.
- Expect that Families will sit together.
- Expect to enjoy the company of your brothers and sisters in Christ.
